

CIRQUE DU SOLEIL EXTENDS MELBOURNE SEASON OF 'KOOZA'

New and final shows on sale this Friday

**Season extended until March 26. No further extension possible! **

Melbourne, VIC – January 11, 2017 – Cirque du Soleil arrives in Melbourne next week with the new production KOOZA, which will open under the famous blue-and-yellow Big Top at Flemington Racecourse on Friday January 20, 2017. Due to incredible demand, Cirque du Soleil is pleased to announce that the Melbourne season will be extended by two weeks until Sunday March 26 2017. No further extension will be possible.

Tickets for the final two weeks of the Melbourne season of *KOOZA* will go on sale this Friday 13 January at www.cirquedusoleil.com/kooza or by phone on toll free 1800 036 685.

One of the most physically astonishing shows in the *Cirque du Soleil* stable, *KOOZA* is a colourful, sparkling homage to the traditions of circus, combining thrilling acrobatics with the art of clowning.

Cirque du Soleil's casting teams search the world for performers at the very top of their craft and this quest for the best is evident in KOOZA, which features breath-taking acts on a scale not regularly seen by local audiences. Some of these include:

The Double High Wire: Two high wires are suspended 5 metres and 8 metres above the stage. The artists are third and sixth generation circus performers and their expert ability allows them to perform feats in the air that most of us would find difficult to do on the ground.

Wheel of Death: KOOZA's 700 kilogram Wheel of Death rotates at heart-stopping speeds, powered only by the two artists who leap and counter-rotate in a death-defying display of fearless acrobatics and astonishing teamwork.

The Teeterboard: The Teeterboard is a giant see-saw that flings artists into the air, where they execute quintuple twisting somersaults—and that's just the prelude! The troupe of over 10 acrobats perform stunts of ever-increasing complexity including spinning 9 metres above the stage and landing with metal stilts strapped to their legs.

The stunning costumes, designed by Marie-Chantale Vaillancourt, have been inspired by the painter Klimt, the Mad Max movies, ancient designs from India and Eastern Europe, clock mechanisms, tin soldiers and more – together the overall look is Alice in Wonderland meets Baron Munchausen meets Wizard of Oz.

The international cast of 50 acrobats, musicians, singers and actors present heart-stopping feats and laugh-out loud antics to a live soundtrack fusion of jazz, funk and Bollywood beats. With nods to Carnivale, the Day of the Dead, military fashion, rock and roll and 1920s cotton club glamour, *KOOZA* is a visual feast. We follow The Innocent as he takes a journey of self-discovery through a comic kingdom of eccentric characters, electrifying thrills and out-of-the-box surprises.
