

FOUR ROSES

Well-known straight Bourbon whisky.

FRAISA

A strawberry liqueur.

FRAISES (Sirop de)

Strawberry syrup.

GALLIANO

Italian liqueur, has liquorice flavour, used for mixing.

GAZEUSE

French name for lemonade containing carbonic acid.

GILBEY GIN

A good London dry gin.

GINGER BEER

English light alcoholic beer.

GOMME (Sirop de)

Sugar syrup used in the bar.

GONZALEZ BYASS & CIA

Well-known excellent sherry "Tio Pepe muy seco" and Gonzalez Port.

GORDON'S

An excellent gin, in addition to the famous London dry Gin: Old Tom Gin, Lemon Gin, Orange Gin.

GRANDE GRUYERE

Excellent herbal liqueur, gold and green colour.

GRAND MARNIER (Cordon Rouge)

World famous French liqueur, based on Cognac and Orange curacao, frequently used for mixing.

GRAPPA

Italian name for Trester (Marc.) This brandy varies greatly in quality.

GRENADINE SYRUP

A pomegranate syrup which is used a lot in France and has a beautiful red colour. It is a favourite addition to mixes.

HARPER

Well-known Bourbon produced from the very best raw materials. It must be stored for six years in whiteoak casks.

HEERING'S CHERRY BRANDY

Cherry liqueur from Denmark, rightly the best known cherry brandy.

HEIDSIECK MONOPOLE

World famous champagne. There is "Heidsieck Monopole demi Sec", "Red Top" dry Monopole brut), Dry Monopole Rose (brut).

HIMBEERGEIST

Favourite spirit obtained from raspberries which is served like cherry water and is also used for mixing.

HULSTKAMP

Dutch liqueurs suitable for mixing of cocktails.

INDIAN QUININE WATER

Tonic water, bitter-sweet alcohol-free drink concentrated with carbonic acid.

IRISH MIST

An Irish whisky which has a slightly different flavour from Scotch whisky. Best known cocktail: "Irish coffee". Well known brands: John Jameson, John Power, Paddy, Tullamore, John Locke and Bush Mills.

IVA FLEUR

A liqueur with Iva aroma.

IZARRA

An excellent French liqueur produced since 1835.

JIM BEAM

A straight Bourbon whisky.

JOHNNIE WALKER

A well-known make, Johnnie Walker Red Label and Black label.

KEUCK

The best known is Keuck Turkish Mocca liqueur, a speciality which is also suitable for mixing.

KING GEORGE IV

Well-known Scotch whisky.

KUEMMEL

Cumin seed brandy seldom used for mixing, should be stored cold.

LANSON

Well-known brand of Champagne.

LARRESINGLE (Chateau de)

Excellent Armagnac.

LILLET

An aperitif based on white wine with cinchona bark and added Armagnac.
